FINAL ORDER DISMISSING PETITION FOR RELIEF FROM AN UNLAWFUL EMPLOYMENT PRACTICE

STATE OF FLORIDA COMMISSION ON HUMAN RELATIONS

Petitioner filed a Charge of Discrimination claiming she was discriminated against on the bases of age and race because she was not hired for a position of employment. In the Petition For Relief she also alleged disability. A hearing was held and no transcript or exceptions were found in the Commission's file. The Judge found for the Respondent on the merits because there was no evidence of discrimination on the bases of age and race and recommended dismissal of the Petition.

The Judge's dismissal on the merits was correct since it was supported by competent substantial evidence in the record, and the Petition should be dismissed. There are no recognizable errors of law as applied to the facts of this case. Disability was not in issue because it was not claimed in the Charge of Discrimination.

Dismissal

The Petition for Relief is hereby dismissed.

The parties have the right to seek judicial review of this Order. The Commission and the appropriate District Court of Appeal must receive a notice of appeal within 30 days of the date this Order is filed with the Clerk of the Commission. Explanation of the right to appeal is found in Section 120.68, Florida Statutes, and in the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, Rule 9.110.
