<u>ORDER</u>

This cause came before the Department of State, Division of Licensing, (hereinafter "Department" or "Division") upon the entering of a Final Order, and the Department being fully advised as to the premises, finds and orders as follows:

- 1. On November 1, 2001, the Division issued a final Order revoking
 Respondent's Class "D" Security Officer's License, number D96-07113, Class "G"
 Statewide Firearms License, number G97-01150 and Class "ZB" Organizational Officer
 Position, number ZB98-00180 and imposing an administrative fine the amount of two thousand dollars.
- 2. On or about December 3, 2001 Respondent timely filed a Notice of Appeal with the Second District Court of Appeal in Lakeland, Florida.
- 3. On January 7, 2002, the Second District Court of Appeal accepted jurisdiction by issuing an acknowledgement of a new case.

- 4. Respondent did not ask for or receive a stay as to the revocation of his licenses.
- 5. On or about November 1, 2002 the District Court of Appeal of the State of Florida Second District reversed and remanded the case to the Department.
- 6. Prior to the decision of the Second District Court of Appeal, the validity period for Respondent's Class "D" Security Officer's License, number D96-07113, and Class "G" Statewide Firearms License, number G97-01150, expired.
- 7. As Respondent did not ask for or receive a stay as to the revocation of his licenses, Respondent's licenses have been, in effect, revoked for over one year.
- 8. Therefore the Division no longer seeks to incur further time and cost in trying to pursue other penalties.

WHEREFORE, based upon the foregoing, and a complete review of the record, it is ORDERED that the Final Order dated November 1, 2001 is hereby VACATED and that the Administrative Complaint dated April 27, 2001 is hereby DISMISSED.
