A formal administrative hearing was conducted pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, on March 22, 2001, before Arnold H. Pollock, a duly assigned Administrative Law Judge of the Division of Administrative Hearings. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


The Department of State hereby adopts and incorporates herein by reference the Conclusions of Law in the Recommended Order.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, and a complete review of the record, it is ORDERED that the Respondent's Class "G" Statewide Firearms License number G97-01150 is placed on reporting PROBATION for a period of one (1) year, the terms of which are attached and adopted and incorporated herein by reference.

NOTICE OF RIGHTS

This Order constitutes final agency action. Any party who is adversely affected by the Order may seek judicial review under Section 120.68, Florida Statutes. Such proceedings are commenced by filing a Notice of Appeal, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, with the Deputy Clerk of the Division of Licensing, Department of State, The Capitol, Mail Station #4, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0250; and by filing a copy of the Notice of Appeal, accompanied by the applicable filing fees, with the First District Court of Appeals, or with the District Court of Appeal in the appellate district where the party resides. The Notice of Appeal must be filed within thirty (30) days of the date this Order is filed with the Clerk of the Department.


