FINAL ORDER

THIS CAUSE is before me as the result of the attached Recommended Order that was issued by an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) who had been assigned to hear the case by the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH). The order recommends that the Department deny the application of Petitioners to renew their foster home license. No exceptions were filed to the Recommended Order.


Petitioners application to renew their foster care license was denied based on the failure of Petitioners to keep their home within foster care licensing standards, as well as exceeding the licensed capacity of the home without approval or waiver of the limit.

After hearing the evidence, the ALJ issued a Recommended Order recommending that the application to renew the Petitioner's foster care license be denied. I hereby

ACCEPT this conclusion and ADOPT the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law of the
Recommended Order.

Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED** that Petitioners' application to renew their foster
care license is **denied** in Case No. 01-1810.
