#### FINAL ORDER

## PRELIMINARY STATEMENT

After being formally notified of the Division of Retirement's intent to deny his request for retirement service credit for his employment with the Florida Bar, Mr. Boggs timely filed a petition for hearing and the case was referred to the Division of Administrative Hearings.

Pursuant to notice, the Division of Administrative Hearings, by its duly designated Administrative Law Judge, Barbara J. Staros, held a formal hearing in the above-styled case on July 13, 2001, in Tallahassee, Florida.

At the formal proceeding, Mr. Boggs presented no testimony or exhibits. Respondent offered the testimony of David Ragsdale, Benefits Administrator, Division of Retirement; who was accepted as an expert in enrollment in the Florida Retirement System. Respondent offered 3 exhibits, including the deposition testimony of George Dillard and Dan Bennett, which were admitted. Official Recognition was taken of Article 5, Section 15, Florida Constitution; The Rules of the Supreme Court of Florida; Chapter 121, Florida Statutes (1999); and Chapter 60S, Florida Administrative Code.

No transcript was ordered and the parties filed their Proposed Recommended Orders more than 10 days after the Formal Hearing. A Recommended Order was issued September 14, 2001, which is incorporated by reference into this Final Order. No exceptions to the Recommended Order have been filed.
