

On June 18, 2001, the undersigned Director of the Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering received a Recommended Order from the Honorable Eleanor M. Hunter, Administrative Law Judge of the Division of Administrative Hearings in DOAH Case Number 01-2185PL.
