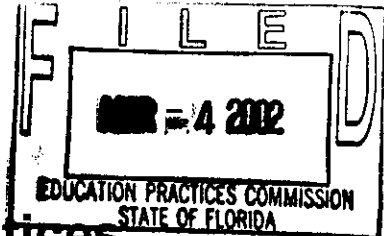

## Final Order

This matter was heard by a Teacher Panel of the Education Practices Commission pursuant to Sections 231.261(8) and 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, on February 22, 2002, in Tampa, Florida, for consideration of the Recommended Order entered in this case by John G. Van Laningham, Administrative Law Judge, dated December 14, 2000, And the Exceptions thereto filed by the Commissioner of Education. After reviewing the complete record accompanying the Recommended Order, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, the Panel denies the Exceptions and hereby adopts the findings of fact, conclusions of law and recommendation contained in the Recommended Order, and said Recommended Order, a copy of which is attached and made a part hereof, is hereby adopted in full by the Education Practices Commission.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority of Section 321.262 (7) (a), Florida Statutes, it is Ordered that the Applicant's application for a Florida Educator's Certificate is hereby denied and he shall not be eligible to reapply for certification for a period of fifteen years from the effective date of this order. Should he tender an application during that period of ineligibility, the Department of Education, or its successor, may refuse to consider it, thereby neither granting nor denying it.

This Order takes effect upon filing with the Clerk of the Education Practices Commission.

THE NOTICE OF APPEAL MUST BE FILED WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS OF RENDITION OF THIS ORDER.
