THIS CAUSE, arising under "the Florida Citrus Code" (Chapter 601, Florida Statutes), came before the Commissioner of Agriculture of the State of Florida for consideration and final agency action. On April 30, 2001, Petitioner, Spyke's Grove, Inc. d/b/a Fresh Fruit Express, Emerald Estate, Nature's Classic, a citrus dealer, filed a written complaint against Respondent, A & J Pak Ship, Inc., a licensed citrus fruit dealer with the Department pursuant to Section 601.66, Florida Statutes. The complaint alleged Respondent's indebtedness to Petitioner in the amount of \$551.16 for citrus fruit purchased from Petitioner. Respondent's license for the subject shipping season is supported by a surety bond written by Old Republic Surety Co. pursuant to Section 601.66, Florida Statutes. Respondent filed an answer to the complaint denying the claim as valid. A hearing was held

on August 29, 2001, by the Division of Administrative Hearings. The Hearing Officer rendered his Recommended Order on September 12, 2001, copy of which is attached hereto as "Exhibit A".

No exceptions were filed.

Upon review of the record and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

- 1. The Hearing Officers recommendation that the department enter a final order dismissing Petitioner's complaint is hereby adopted.

Review proceedings must be instituted by filing a petition or notice of appeal with the Agency Clerk in the Legal Office, Room 515, Mayo Building, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0800, and a copy, accompanied by filing fees as prescribed by law, with the appropriate District Court of Appeal within thirty (30) days of rendition of this Final Order.
