FINAL ORDER DISMISSING REQUEST FOR RELIEF FROM AN UNLAWFUL EMPLOYMENT PRACTICE

Petitioner filed a Petition for Relief claim she was discriminated against because of a racially hostile work environment, causing her constructive discharge from employment. A hearing was held. A transcript of the proceedings was not made. No exceptions were found in the file. There was an attempt made to use a transcript found in another similar case to show a racially hostile environment in Respondent's workplace, but the Judge did not mention this transcript in her Recommended Order, and it is unclear whether it was included in the record. In any event it is hearsay. A review of the case compels a decision against the Petitioner since she refused to clean an exceptionally dirty restroom even though it was part of her job duties, and left her place of employment without ever returning.

The Judge's dismissal was correct since it was supported by competent substantial evidence in the record, and the Petition should be dismissed. There are no recognizable errors of law as applied to the facts of this case.

DISMISSAL

The Petition for Relief is hereby **Dismissed**.

The Parties have the right to seek judicial review of this Order. The Commission and the appropriate District Court of Appeal must receive a Notice of Appeal within 30 days of the date of this Order is filed with the Clerk of the Commission. Explanation of the right to appeal is found in Section 120.68, Florida Statutes, and the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure 9.110.
