# FINAL ORDER

This matter comes before me for final Agency Order.

The issue before me is whether the Petitioner, Moishes Steakhouse & Seafood d/b/a Piccolo Mondo Continental Cuisine timely submitted an application to record a lien for license number 23-02731, 4COP.

# PRELIMINARY STATEMENT

- 1. On or about October 11, 1999, the Division issued a letter to the Petitioner acknowledging receipt of a request to record a lien against alcoholic beverage license 23-02731. The Division denied the request.
- 2. Petitioner timely filed request for a formal hearing, citing disputed issues of fact and the matter was forwarded to the Division of Administrative Hearings.

- 3. A formal hearing was conducted by Administrative Law Judge J. D. Parrish on December 14, 2001.
- 4. A Recommended Order was issued by Administrative Law Judge Parrish on March 1, 2002.
- 5. Exceptions to the Recommended Order were received from Respondent on March 15, 2002.

### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 6. A thorough review of the entire record of this matter reveals that the findings of fact contained in the recommended order are based on competent, substantial evidence and that the proceedings on which the findings were based complied with the essential requirements of the law.
- 7. The Division hereby adopts and incorporates by reference the Findings of Fact as set forth in the Recommended Order.

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 8. A thorough review of the entire record in this matter indicates that the Conclusions of Law contained in the Recommended Order are reasonable and correct interpretations of the law based on the Findings of Fact. Respondent's exceptions are thus rejected.
- 9. The Division hereby adopts and incorporates by reference the Conclusions of Law as set forth in the Recommended Order.
  - 10. This Final Order is entered after a review of the complete record.
