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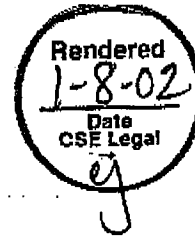

FINAL ORDER

Lillie Bogan, as Director of the Department of Revenue, Child Support Enforcement Program (Department), being authorized by Section 409.25656, Florida Statutes, to garnish bank accounts of obligors who owe overdue support, enters this Final Order in the above referenced matter.

PRELIMINARY STATEMENT

Petitioner's address is DC#T18277, 699 Ike Steele Road, Wewahitchka, Florida 32465. By Notice of Intent to Levy dated March 27, 2001, the Department notified Petitioner that, pursuant to Section 409.25656, Florida Statutes, it intended to levy on Petitioner's credits consisting of liquid assets in the control of Tampa Bay Federal Credit Union. Petitioner, pursuant to section 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, timely requested a formal administrative hearing before the Division of Administrative Hearings. An administrative hearing was held by teleconference in Tallahassee, Florida on December 12, 2001 before Administrative Law Judge Suzanne Hood. The Administrative Law

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Judge issued a Recommended Order in this matter on December 13, 2001, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein. Neither party filed exceptions to the Recommended Order.

1. The Department adopts and incorporates by reference the Findings of Fact set forth in the Recommended Order.


CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

ORDER

BASED UPON said Findings of Facts and Conclusions of Law, it is ORDERED that, pursuant to Section 409.25656, Florida Statutes, the Department of Revenue, Child Support Enforcement Program may levy on Petitioner's credits consisting of liquid assets in the control of Tampa Bay Federal Credit Union up to the amount of \$53.00. This Order is effective upon filing with the Deputy Agency Clerk, subject only to Notice of Right Appeal incorporated herein.


