A copy of the notice, together with the appropriate filing fee, shall also be filed with the Clerk, District Court of Appeal, First Appellate District, 301 Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-1850. If the 30th day following the date of the filing of this order with the Agency Clerk falls on a Saturday, Sunday or a day when the school board office is otherwise closed, the notice of appeal must be filed on the next day that the school board office is open for business. If you fail to file your notice of appeal within the time prescribed by law and the rules of court, you will lose your right to appeal this final order.
