FINAL ORDER


After completely reviewing the record and being otherwise fully advised, the Commission: adopts the Recommended Order and **ORDERS** the denial of Petitioner's application for licensure as a real estate salesperson.

This Final Order shall be effective thirty days from date of filing with the Clerk of the Department of Business and Professional Regulation. However, any party affected by this Order has the right to seek judicial review, pursuant to Section 120.68 of the Florida Statutes, and to Section 9.110 of the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.

Within thirty days of the filing date of this Final Order, review proceedings may be instituted by filing a Notice of Appeal with the Clerk of the Department of Business and Professional

Regulation at Suite 308N, 400 West Robinson Street, Orlando, Florida 32801. At the same time, a copy of the Notice of Appeal with applicable filing fees must be filed with the appropriate District Court of Appeal.
