
MOTION TO RE-OPEN FILE

NOW COMES Respondent, the Florida Department of Revenue, Child Support Enforcement Program (DOR), by and through the undersigned counsel, pursuant to Rule 28-106.204, F.A.C., and hereby moves the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH) for an order re-opening DOAH's file in this case. In support of this motion, Respondent states:

1. On March 10, 2003, DOR filed a Motion to Relinquish Jurisdiction on the grounds, primarily, that Petitioner, Michael L. Wright, was a patient at the Florida State Hospital, Chattahoochee, Florida; that DOR had requested that DOAH appoint a guardian ad litem for Petitioner; and that DOAH had denied DOR's request on the grounds that it did not have authority to do so.
2. Petitioner since has been released from the Florida State Hospital and now resides at the Carolyn David Adult Family Home in Tampa, Florida.
3. Consequently, DOR believes there is no longer any legal impediment to DOAH's adjudication of this case.

WHEREFORE, DOR respectfully requests that DOAH issue an order re-opening this case.


