### FINAL ORDER

This cause was referred to the Division of Administrative Hearings and assigned to an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) for a formal administrative hearing and the entry of a Recommended Order. The Recommended Order of August 22, 2003, is attached to this Final Order, and incorporated herein by reference.

#### **RULING ON EXCEPTIONS**

This case concerns a nursing home (Englewood Healthcare and Rehabilitation Center) that was the subject of two administrative complaints; one seeking to assign conditional licensure status and the other seeking to impose administrative fines and fees of \$26,000.00. The facts alleged in both complaints were that the nursing home had

failed to ensure the safety of residents who smoke. The Agency filed exceptions to finding of fact 13 and conclusion of law 45. Respondent filed a response to the exceptions.

The exception to finding of fact 13 is rejected because the Agency failed to show that there was no competent, substantial evidence to support the finding. See generally Section 120.57(1)(*I*), Fla. Stat. (providing in pertinent part that "(t)he agency may not reject or modify the findings of fact unless the agency first determines from a review of the entire record...that the findings of fact were not based upon competent substantial evidence); Heifetz v. Department of Bus. Regulation, 475 So.2d 1277, 1281 (Fla, 1985)(holding that an agency "may not reject the hearing officer's finding (of fact) unless there is no competent, substantial evidence from which the finding could reasonably be inferred.").

The exception to conclusion of law 45 is rejected because it is based on accepted findings of fact and the Agency cannot come to a different conclusion that is as or more reasonable than that of the ALJ. See Section 102.57(1)(*I*), Fla. Stat.

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

The Agency adopts the findings set forth in the Recommended Order, which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

The Agency adopts the conclusions of law set forth in the Recommended Order.

# IT IS THEREFORE ADJUDGED THAT:

The administrative complaints filed against the Respondent in this cause are dismissed.
