

Final Order

This matter was heard by a Teacher Panel of the Education Practices Commission pursuant to Sections 1012.795, 1012.796 and 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, on September 19, 2003, in Tampa, Florida, for consideration of the Recommended Order entered in this case by Charles C. Adams, Administrative Law Judge, dated July 16, 2003. Respondent filed *Exceptions to Recommended Order* which the Commission denied. After reviewing the complete record accompanying the Recommended Order, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, the Panel hereby adopts the findings of fact in paragraphs 1 - 65, conclusions of law in paragraphs 66 - 81, recommendation contained in the Recommended Order, and said Recommended Order, a copy of which is attached and made a part hereof, is hereby adopted in full and becomes the Final Order of the Education Practices Commission.

It is therefore ORDERED that count 2 of the Administrative Complaint is DISMISSED. Respondent is found to be in violation of Count 1 and Counts 3, 4, 5, and 6 of the Administrative Complaint. It is further Ordered that the educator's certificate of Troy Doyle is revoked for two years from the date of this Final Order.

This Order takes effect upon filing with the Clerk of the Education Practices Commission.
