FINAL ORDER

The Adjutant General of the Department of Military Affairs ("Agency") enters this Final Order in the above-referenced matter.

PRELIMINARY STATEMENT

On April 3, 2003, R. Christopher Goodwin & Associates, Inc. ("Goodwin") filed a Formal Written Protest and Petition for Formal Hearing with the Division of Administrative Hearings ("Division") challenging a proposed award of contract for performing Cultural Resource Surveys to Southeastern Archeological Research, Inc. ("SEARCH").

SEARCH intervened as a party in the proceeding. On April 8, 2003, as noticed, Hearing on Goodwin's Petition commences, pursuant to Section 120.57(1), Florida Statutes. Upon conclusion of the Hearing, the parties requested a transcript and timely submitted proposed recommended orders which were considered by the Administrative Law Judge.

On October 3, 2003, the Administrative Law Judge issued her Recommended Order, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, in which she recommended that the Agency issue a Final Order denying Goodwin's Petition and approving the intended award of the contract to SEARCH. The order advised the parties of the right to submit written exceptions to the Agency within ten days of the Recommended Order. None of the parties file exceptions.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Agency adopts and incorporates herein by reference the Findings of Fact set forth in the Recommended Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Agency adopts and incorporates herein by reference the Conclusions of Law set forth in the Recommended Order.

<u>ORDER</u>

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, it is therefore ORDERED:

Goodwin's Formal Written Protest and Petition is denied and the award of contract to SEARCH for archeological services is approved. This Order is effective upon filing with the State Quartermaster for the Agency.
