FINAL ORDER

THIS CAUSE came before the DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS AND PROFESSIONAL REGULATION'S DIVISION OF PARI-MUTUEL WAGERING (hereinafter referred to as the "Division") pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, for the purpose of considering the Administrative Law Judge's (hereinafter the "ALJ") Recommended Order, Respondent's Exceptions to the Recommended Order, and Petitioner's Response to Respondent's Exceptions to the Recommended Order (copies of which are attached hereto as Exhibits A, B, and Petitioner was represented by Joseph M. RESPONDENT'S EXCEPTIONS

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The ALJ's findings of fact set forth in the Recommended Order are approved, adopted and incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. There is competent substantial evidence to support the findings of fact as set forth in the Recommended Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Division has jurisdiction of this matter pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57(1) and Chapter 550, Florida Statutes.
- 2. The conclusions of law set forth in the Recommended Order are hereby approved, adopted and incorporated herein by reference.
- 3. There is competent substantial evidence to support the Division's findings and conclusions.

DISPOSITION

Upon a complete review of the record in this case, the Division determines that the disposition recommended by the Administrative Law Judge be ACCEPTED.

IT IS HEREBY **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that Respondent's thoroughbred racing permit is hereby REVOKED and the denial of Respondent's previous application for a racing license for the 2003-2004 thoroughbred racing season is hereby AFFIRMED.
