FINAL ORDER

- 2. Respondent's manager(s) shall attend a Hospitality Education Program class within 60 days of the filing of this final order and provide proof of attendance to the Division of Hotels and Restaurants.
- 3. This Final Order shall become effective on the date of filing with the Agency Clerk.
