by filing a Notice of Appeal with the Clerk of the Department of Business and Professional Regulation at Suite 308N, 400 West Robinson Street, Orlando, Florida 32801. At the same time, a copy of the Notice of Appeal with applicable filing fees must be filed with the appropriate District Court of Appeal.
