FINAL ORDER

THIS CAUSE is before me upon the attached Recommended Order (RO) that was issued by the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) assigned to hear the case by the Division of Administrative Hearings. A Transcript of the hearing was not filed with the Agency Clerk. No exceptions to the Recommended Order were filed. The Order recommends that the department enter a Final Order requiring the Petitioner to repay the Respondent \$1,165.76.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. All findings of fact in the ALJ's RO are adopted and incorporated herein by reference.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

2. All conclusions of law contained in the ALJ's RO are accepted, adopted and incorporated herein by reference.

And the undersigned being fully advised, it is therefore **ORDERED** that The Petitioner's shall repay the Respondent \$1,165.76., which constitutes the amount she was overpaid the Respondent. **Unless the Petitioner makes arrangements with the Human Resources/Payroll department for installment payments, the Petitioner shall remit full payment to the department within 20 days of the filing date of this Order. If the department does not receive full payment within this time, it shall pursue payment through any and all legal means.**



NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL

To initiate judicial review, the party seeking it must file one copy of a "Notice of Appeal" with the Agency Clerk. The party seeking judicial review must also file another copy of the "Notice of Appeal," accompanied by the filing fee required by law, with the First District Court of Appeal in Tallahassee, Florida, or with the District Court of Appeal in the district where the party resides. The Notices must be filed within thirty (30) days of the rendition of this final order.¹
