FINAL ORDER

This proceeding was initiated by the Petitioners, CROWN OUTDOOR ADVERTISING, INC., AND TROPICAL LANDHOLDINGS, INC. (hereinafter CROWN), filing a Petition requesting an administrative hearing with the Respondent, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (hereinafter DEPARTMENT), on October 22, 2003. The Petition was filed in response to three (3) Notices of Denied Application (hereinafter Notices) for state sign permit application numbers 54579, 54580, 54581, 54582, 54583, and 54584, issued by the DEPARTMENT on September 23, 2003. CROWN proposed to locate the signs at State Road 93 (Interstate 75) south of Toledo Blade Boulevard, in Sarasota County, Florida. On April 19, 2004, the matter was referred to the Division of

Administrative Hearings (hereinafter DOAH) for assignment of an administrative law judge and a formal hearing.

A formal administrative hearing was held in this matter in Tallahassee, Florida, on October 7, 2004, before the Honorable Fred L. Buckine, a duly appointed administrative law judge. Appearances on behalf of the parties were as follows:

At the hearing, CROWN presented the testimony of Lynn Holschuh, the DEPARTMENT'S state outdoor advertising administrator, and James Taylor Duff, a part owner in Tropical Landholdings, Inc. CROWN presented Petitioner's Exhibits A, B, and C, which were admitted into evidence. The DEPARTMENT also presented the testimony of Ms. Holschuh; and presented Respondent's Exhibits 2, 3, and 4, which were admitted into evidence. Official recognition was taken of Chapter 479, Florida Statutes (2003); 23 C.F.R. § 750.708; Florida Administrative Code Rules 9J-5.003 and 14-10.0052; the City of North Port's Ordinance 02-46; the City of North Port's Comprehensive Plan; and the Final Order in DOAH Case No. 03-3682 issued on February 16, 2004, by Judge Barbara Staros. The transcript of the proceedings was filed on

October 22, 2004. On November 10 and 15, 2004, the **DEPARTMENT** and **CROWN** filed their respective Proposed Recommended Orders. On January 19, 2005, Judge Buckine issued his Recommended Order. No exceptions to the Recommended Order were filed.

FINDINGS OF FACT

After review of the record in its entirety, it is determined that the Findings of Fact in paragraphs 1 through 18 of the Recommended Order are supported by competent, substantial evidence. As such, they are adopted and incorporated as if fully set forth herein.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The **DEPARTMENT** has jurisdiction over the subject matter of and the parties to this proceeding pursuant to Chapter 120 and Chapter 479, Florida Statutes.
- 2. The Conclusions of Law in paragraphs 20 through 24 of the Recommended Order are fully supported in the law. As such, they are adopted and incorporated as if fully set forth herein.

ORDER

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, it is

ORDERED that the Recommended Order and recommendations therein are adopted.

It is further

ORDERED that the Notices of Denied Application issued by the Respondent,

DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, to the Petitioners, CROWN OUTDOOR

ADVERTISING, INC., AND TROPICAL LANDHOLDINGS, INC., are hereby affirmed.
