Davis recommended that the Department issue a final order dismissing the petition. The Recommended Order concluded that the Petitioner had not met its burden of proving that it was entitled to the \$545,124.00 collected by the Department of Financial Services following an investigation and audit. The parties did not file any exceptions.

Based on the foregoing, the Department of Education finds that Abilities, Inc.'s petition and amended petition is hereby dismissed.
