

FINAL ORDER

The Respondent Kim Littrell is a teacher employed by the Petitioner St. Lucie County School Board. The Petitioner, by and through the Superintendent of Schools, sought termination of the Respondent's employment for just cause in accordance with Section 1012.33, Florida Statutes.

The Respondent requested a formal administrative hearing and one was held on November 30, 2004, before an Administrative Law Judge of the Division of Administrative Hearings of the Florida Department of Administration. On April 1, 2005 the Administrative Law Judge entered a Recommended Order finding just cause for terminating the Respondent from employment by the School Board. The Recommended Order has been forwarded to the School Board in accordance with Section 120.57(1), Florida Statutes. The Recommended Order is attached to and made a part of this Final Order.

Written exceptions to the Recommended Order were due April 18, 2005. Neither the Superintendent nor the Respondent filed exceptions to the Recommended Order. By motion filed May 2, 2005, the Superintendent of Schools has requested that the School Board adopt the Recommended Order, and enter a final order finding just cause to terminate the Respondent from employment by the Petitioner.

The School Board met on May 10, 2005, in Fort Pierce, St. Lucie County, Florida, to take final

agency action. The Superintendent of Schools recommended upholding the findings of fact,

conclusions of law, and recommendation set forth in the recommended order.

WHEREFORE, it is hereby found and determined that upon consideration of the motion and

recommendation of the Superintendent, just cause exists for terminating the employment of the

Respondent Kim Littrell. The School Board therefore adopts the findings of fact, conclusions of law,

and recommendation set forth in the Recommended Order.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Respondent be and she is hereby terminated from her

employment with the School Board of St. Lucie County, Florida. This order shall take effect upon

filing with the Superintendent of Schools as Secretary of the SCHOOL BOARD OF ST. LUCIE

COUNTY, FLORIDA.

A copy of this Final Order shall be provided to the Florida Division of Administrative

Hearings within 15 days of filing, as set forth in Section 120.57(1)(m), Florida Statutes. DONE
