FINAL ORDER OF THE SCHOOL BOARD OF -MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA

THIS CAUSE having come on for hearing before The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its regular meeting of January 19, 2005, upon the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Order, recommending that Larry J. Williams' thirty (30) work day suspension from employment without pay from The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida be rescinded, and the Board having been fully advised in the premises, it is thereupon ordered by The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, that:

- 1. The Administrative Law Judge's findings of fact, conclusions of law and recommendation attached hereto, be and the same are hereby adopted as the Final Order of The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida;
- 2. The thirty (30) work day suspension without pay of Larry J. Williams is hereby rescinded;
- 3. Larry J. Williams' supervisor shall enter a written reprimand into Mr. Williams' personnel file;
- 4. Larry J. Williams shall receive any back salary which would have

accrued during his suspension, with 7% interest, and any benefits that would have accrued during his suspension if he had been working.
