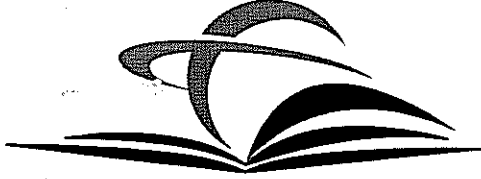

**FINAL ORDER OF THE SCHOOL BOARD

THIS CAUSE having come on for hearing before The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its regular meeting of November 16, 2005, upon the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Order, recommending that Anthony C. Brooks' thirty (30) work day suspension without pay be rescinded, and the Board having been fully advised in the premises, it is thereupon ordered by The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, that:

1. The Administrative Law Judge's findings of fact, conclusions of law and recommendation, attached hereto, be and the same are hereby adopted as the Final Order of The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida;
2. The thirty (30) work day suspension without pay of Anthony C. Brooks be and the same is hereby rescinded; and
3. Anthony C. Brooks be awarded the back salary and benefits which accrued during the thirty (30) work day suspension with 10% interest thereon.
