- The Administrative Law Judge's findings of fact, conclusions of law and recommendation, attached hereto, be and the same are hereby adopted as the Final Order of The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida;
- 2. The thirty (30) work day suspension without pay of Anthony C. Brooks be and the same is hereby rescinded; and
- 3. Anthony C. Brooks be awarded the back salary and benefits which accrued during the thirty (30) work day suspension with 10% interest thereon.
