FINAL ORDER

THIS CAUSE came on for consideration and final agency action. On December 30, 2004, a Notice of Denial was issued by the Department of Financial Services denying the license application of the Petitioner, Francisco Luis Inguanzo, as a resident public all lines insurance adjuster because of his criminal history and failure to reveal it. The Petitioner timely filed a request for a proceeding, which was referred to the Division of Administrative Hearings in order to conduct a Section 120.57(1), Florida Statutes hearing. Pursuant to notice, the matter was heard before J.D. Parrish, Administrative Law Judge, Division of Administrative Hearings, on April 26, 2005.

After consideration of the record and argument presented at hearing, the Administrative Law Judge issued her Recommended Order on June 30, 2005. (Attached as Exhibit A). The Administrative Law Judge recommended that the Department enter a Final Order denying the Petitioner's application for licensure.

Neither party filed exceptions to the Recommended Order.

Therefore, upon careful consideration of the entire record, the submissions of the parties, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The Findings of Fact of the Administrative Law Judge are adopted in full as the Department's Findings of Fact.
- 2. The Conclusions of Law of the Administrative Law Judge are adopted in full as the Department's Conclusions of Law.
- 3. The Administrative Law Judge's recommendation that the Department enter a Final Order denying the Petitioner's application for licensure is approved and accepted as being the appropriate disposition of this case.

ACCORDINGLY, it is ORDERED that Petitioner's, FRANCISCO LUIS

INGUANZO'S, application for licensure as a resident public all lines insurance adjuster in this

State is hereby DENIED.

NOTICE OF RIGHTS

Any party to these proceedings adversely affected by this Order is entitled to seek review of the Order pursuant to Section 120.68, Florida Statutes, and Rule 9.110, Fla.R.App.P. Review proceedings must be instituted by filing a petition or Notice of Appeal with the General Counsel, acting as the agency clerk, at 200 East Gaines Street, Tallahassee, FL 32399-0333, and a copy of the same and the filing fee with the appropriate District Court of Appeal within thirty (30) days of the rendition of this Order.
