FINAL ORDER

CAUSE before the came BOARD OF NURSING December 14, 2005, pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, on December 14, 2005, via teleconference, for the purpose of considering the RECOMMENDED ORDER filed by the Division of Administrative Hearings on November 21, 2005. copy of the recommended Order is attached hereto incorporated herein as Exhibit A.

Upon review of the recommended order the argument of the parties, and after a review of the complete record in this case, the Board makes the following Findings and Conclusions:

RULINGS ON EXCEPTIONS

- 1. Exception A is rejected on the grounds that the record contains competent substantial evidence to support the findings of fact in paragraphs 3 and 4.
- 2. Exception B is rejected on the grounds that the record contains competent substantial evidence in paragraphs 6 and 7.
- 3. Exception C is rejected on the grounds that the record contains competent substantial evidence in paragraphs 1-14.
- 4. Exception D is rejected on the grounds that the record contains competent substantial evidence in paragraphs 6-14.
- 5. Exception E is rejected on the grounds that the record contains competent substantial evidence in paragraphs 6-14.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The findings of fact set forth in the recommended order are approved and adopted and incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. There is competent substantial evidence to support the findings of fact.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Board has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Section 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, and Chapter 464, Florida Statutes.
- 2. The conclusions of law set forth in the Recommended Order are approved and adopted and incorporated herein by reference.

DISPOSITION

Upon a complete review of the record in this case, the Board determines that the disposition recommended by the Administrative Law Judge is ACCEPTED.

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Petitioner's approval to operate a nurse education program is rescinded.
