



Final Order

This matter was heard by a Teacher Panel of the Education Practices Commission pursuant to Sections 1012.795, 1012.796 and 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, on June 21, 2006 in Tampa, Florida, for consideration of the Recommended Order entered in this case by J.D. Parrish, Administrative Law Judge dated May 2, 2006. Petitioner was represented by Ronald Stowers, Esquire. Respondent was not present.

After reviewing the complete record accompanying the Recommended Order, the Recommended Order, and being fully advised in the premises:

The Panel hereby adopts the findings of fact (paragraphs 1-17) and conclusions of law (paragraphs 18-26) in the Recommended Order. The Panel adopts the recommendation contained in the Recommended Order as clarified below. A copy of the Recommended Order, attached to and made a part hereof, is hereby adopted in full and becomes the Final Order of the Education Practices Commission.

It is therefore **ORDERED** that:

- 1. The Respondent's certificate is suspended through June 30, 2007.
- 2. Respondent is permanently barred from applying for another Florida educator's certificate.

SUCH PROCEEDINGS ARE COMMENCED BY FILING ONE COPY OF A NOTICE OF APPEAL WITH THE EDUCATION PRACTICES COMMISSION AND A SECOND COPY, ACCOMPANIED BY FILING FEES PRESCRIBED BY LAW, WITH THE DISTRICT COURT OF APPEAL, FIRST DISTRICT, OR WITH THE DISTRICT COURT OF APPEAL IN THE APPELLATE DISTRICT WHERE THE PARTY RESIDES. THE NOTICE OF APPEAL MUST BE FILED WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS OF RENDITION OF THIS ORDER.
