An Administrative Law Judge of the Division of
Administrative Hearings has entered an Order Closing File in this
proceeding. A copy of the Order is attached to this Final Order
as Exhibit A.

BACKGROUND

This is a proceeding to determine whether the City of Frostproof Comprehensive Plan Amendment 05-1, adopted by Ordinance Numbers 2005-50, 2005-51, 2005-52, and 2005-53 on October 31, 2005, as remediated by Comprehensive Plan Amendments 07-R1 adopted by Ordinance Number 2007-23 on July 9, 2007; 07-R2

adopted by Ordinance Number 2007-38 on December 17, 2007; and 09-R1 adopted by Ordinance Number 2009-01 on April 6, 2009, is "in compliance" with the Local Government Comprehensive Planning and Land Development Regulation Act, Ch. 163, Part II, Florida Statutes (the "Act").

The City and the Department entered into four Stipulated Settlement Agreements to resolve Ordinance Numbers 2005-50, 2005-51, and 2005-52, which required the City to adopt certain remedial amendments. The City adopted the remedial amendments and the Department subsequently published its Cumulative Notices of Intent to find the Plan Amendments and the Remedial Amendments to be "in compliance" with Chapter 163, Part II, Florida Statutes, and Rule 9J-5, Florida Administrative Code.

No affected person, as defined by Section 163.3184(1)(a), Florida Statutes, filed a petition challenging the Cumulative Notices, and the time for doing so has expired.

By Ordinance Number 2009-22, adopted on November 2, 2009, the City of Frostproof rescinded Ordinance Number 2005-53. By virtue of this rescission, the instant controversy has been rendered moot and this proceeding must be dismissed. See Department of Highway Safety & Motor Vehicles v. Heredia, 520 So. 2d 61 (Fla. 3d DCA 1988) (dismissing case on appeal as moot where suspension of driver's license was rescinded by the Department).

A COPY OF THE NOTICE OF APPEAL MUST BE FILED WITH THE APPROPRIATE DISTRICT COURT OF APPEAL AND MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY THE FILING FEE SPECIFIED IN SECTION 35.22(3), FLORIDA STATUTES.

YOU WAIVE YOUR RIGHT TO JUDICIAL REVIEW IF THE NOTICE OF APPEAL IS NOT TIMELY FILED WITH THE AGENCY CLERK AND THE APPROPRIATE DISTRICT COURT OF APPEAL.
