DISPOSITION


Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in the referenced Recommended Order, it is hereby ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

By possessing a Bluetooth wireless communication device during administration of the Florida Educational Leadership Examination (FELE) on January 21, 2006, Petitioner violated the test-security procedures that the Department of Education has

imposed on the FELE. Therefore, Petitioner's scores on subparts one, two, and three of the Florida Education Leadership Exam administered on January 21, 2006, are invalidated.

This order becomes effective upon filing with the Agency Clerk of the Department of Education, subject to the Notice of Rights attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Notice of Rights


