FINAL ORDER

THIS CAUSE came on for consideration and final agency action. On June 15, 2006, a letter was sent by Respondent, Department of Financial Services, wherein the Department denied Petitioner, Randall Lee Woodall, Sr.'s application for licensure as a resident independent all-lines insurance adjuster. The Petitioner timely filed a request for a proceeding pursuant to Section 120.57(2), Florida Statutes. Pursuant to notice, the matter was heard before the Honorable Suzanne F. Hood, Administrative Law Judge, Division of Administrative Hearings, on September 14, 2006, in Tallahassee, Florida.

After consideration of the evidence, argument and testimony presented at hearing, the Administrative Law Judge issued a Recommended Order on October 11, 2006. (Attached as Exhibit A) The Administrative Law Judge found the Department to have properly denied Petitioner's application and recommended that the Department enter a Final Order denying Petitioner's application for licensure.

No exceptions to the Recommended Order were filed.

The Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law of the Administrative Law Judge are adopted in full as the Department's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.


The Administrative Law Judge's recommendation that the Department enter a Final Order finding the Department to have properly denied Petitioner's application and recommendation that the Department enter a Final Order denying Petitioner's application for licensure as a resident independent all-lines insurance adjuster, is ACCEPTED as being the appropriate disposition of this case.

ACCORDINGLY, Petitioner's application is denied.

NOTICE OF RIGHTS

Any party to these proceedings adversely affected by this Order is entitled to seek review of the Order pursuant to Section 120.68, Florida Statutes, and Rule 9.110, Fla.R.App.P Review proceedings must be instituted by filing a petition or Notice of Appeal with the General Counsel, acting as the agency clerk, at 200 East Gaines Street, Tallahassee, FL 32399-0333, and a copy of the same and the filing fee with the appropriate District Court of Appeal within thirty (30) days of the rendition of this Order.
