Accordingly, it is

ORDERED and ADJUDGED that Petitioner, St. Pete Jeep, Inc. d/b/a St. Pete Powersports, be granted a license as a dealer for the sale of Zhejiang Lingyun (ZHEL), Chongqing Zongshen (ZONG), and Jiangsu Linhai (LINH) at 555 34th Street South, St. Petersburg (Pinellas County), Florida 33711 upon compliance with all applicable requirements of Section 320.27, Florida Statutes, and all applicable Department rules.


It is further ordered that petitioner may not sell motorcycles manufactured by Chongqing Lifan (CHOL) pursuant to the fact that petitioner failed to satisfy their burden of proof by

showing that respondent is "not providing adequate representation" pursuant to section 320.642

(2) (a2), Florida Statutes.
