FINAL ORDER

This cause came on for consideration of and final agency action on the Recommended Order filed on February 8, 2008, by Administrative Law Judge Lawrence P. Stevenson (ALJ), pursuant to a formal hearing conducted on August 14 and 21, 2007, recommending the imposition of a penalty in the amount of \$ 250.00 against Laura J. King (King), for non-compliance with the notice of address change requirements in Section 626.551, Florida Statutes, and the dismissal of all other counts of the Administrative Complaint related to the practice of "sliding", as defined in Section 6726.9541(1)(z), Fla. Stat. Neither party filed exceptions.

The Recommended Order (a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, and is incorporated hereinto), the transcript of proceedings in the formal hearing, the exhibits introduced into evidence, and applicable law have all been considered during the promulgation of this final order. Said consideration shows that the ALJ's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law are supported by competent, substantial evidence.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, the ALJ's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law are adopted as the Department's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and

IT IS ALSO ORDERED that Laura J. King shall pay the sum of \$250.00 to the Department within thirty days from the date hereof as authorized by Section 626.681(1), Florida Statutes. Failure to pay the administrative penalty within the specified time limit will constitute a violation of Sections 626.681 and 626.8698, Florida Statutes, and will result in the immediate suspension of Respondent's licenses and appointments for a period of sixty (60) days. Respondent's license(s) shall not thereafter be reinstated except upon written request of Respondent. Reinstatement shall be conditioned upon Respondent's compliance with all terms of this Final Order.
