FINAL ORDER ADOPTING THE FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE

Pursuant to notice, a formal hearing was held in this matter on August 31, 2007, before the Division of Administrative Hearings by Administrative Law Judge Robert S. Cohen in Pensacola, Florida. The subject matter of the hearing was whether the Petitioner was entitled to damages and back salary for the period of April 22, 2004, through May 31, 2006, pursuant to Subsection 1012.33(3)(g), Fla. Stat. (2007), as well as interest and attorney's fees.

Judge Cohen issued a Recommended Order on December 21, 2007. Judge Cohen determined that Respondent had correctly denied the inclusion of Petitioner's 20 years of service in Alabama when placing Petitioner on the salary schedule. Judge Cohen made findings of fact and conclusions of law, which are supported by the record.

Pursuant to Section 120.57(1)(1), Fla. Stat., the School Board of Escambia County hereby adopts the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained in the Recommended Order, which is specifically incorporated by reference and attached. The Petitioner's claim for back salary in the amount of \$39,209.50, as well as pre- and post-judgment interest on this amount and attorney's fees and costs is hereby DENIED.

Petitioner has thirty (30) days from the rendition of this Order to file a notice of appeal in accordance with Section 120.68, Fla. Stat.
