**FINAL ORDER**

THIS MATTER came before the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services [hereinafter "Department"], pursuant to Section 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, on August 12, 2008, in Tallahassee, Florida for consideration of the Administrative Law Judge's [hereinafter "ALJ"] Recommended Order (Exhibit A, attached) in the above-styled case, issued May 19, 2008. On June 4, 2008, Respondent requested an extension of time to file exceptions to the Recommended Order. An Order granting the extension of time was issued on June 16, 2008. Respondent thereafter failed to file any exceptions, and the deadline for filing exceptions has since expired. 2. The ALJ's Recommended Conclusions of Law are approved and adopted *in toto* and are incorporated herein by reference as the conclusions of law of the Department.


**ORDER**
