This cause came on before Chief Financial Officer Alex Sink, as head of the Department of Financial Services (the Department), for consideration of and final agency action on the Recommended Order issued herein by Administrative Law Judge Jeff B. Clark on May 16, 2008, after a formal hearing conducted pursuant to Section 120.57(1), Florida Statutes. No exceptions were filed.


After review of the record, including the transcript of proceedings and admitted exhibits, and being otherwise fully apprised in all material premises,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Findings of Fact made by the Administrative Law Judge are adopted as the Department's Findings of Fact, and that the Conclusions of Law reached by the Administrative Law Judge are adopted as the Department's Conclusions of Law.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Recommendation made by the Administrative Law Judge is adopted by the Department, and that Liberty Towing and Recovery, Inc., is directed to pay the sum of \$66, 762.01 to the Department within thirty days from the date hereof.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Second Amended Order of Penalty Assessment and the Stop Work Order entered by the Division of Workers' Compensation is affirmed, and that Petitioners shall cease all business operations unless and until they provide evidence satisfactory to the Division of Workers' Compensation of having now complied with the workers' compensation law by securing the necessary workers' compensation insurance coverage for covered employees and, pursuant to Section 440.107(7)(a), Florida Statutes, paying the civil penalty imposed herein.
