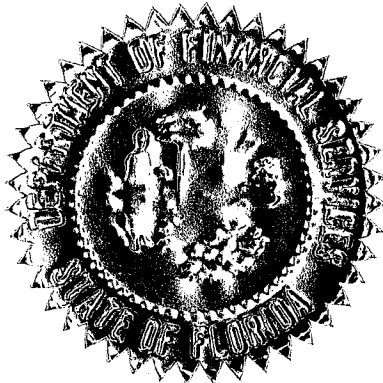
FINAL ORDER
