BACKGROUND

This is a proceeding to determine whether the City of Cape Coral (City) Comprehensive Plan Amendment 09-R1, adopted by Ordinance 63-09, on November 30, 2009, is "in compliance" with the Local Government Comprehensive Planning and Land Development Regulation Act, Ch. 163, Part II, Florida Statutes (the "Act").

On December 27, 2007, the Department issued its Notice of Intent to find the City Comprehensive Plan Amendment 07-1ER adopted by Ordinance 37-07 "in compliance." Petitioners

challenged the 07-1ER amendment by filing a Petition for Hearing on January 15, 2008.

All parties to this proceeding entered into a Stipulated Settlement Agreement which required the City to adopt certain amendments. The City adopted the amendments and the Department subsequently published its Notice of Intent to find the amendments "in compliance" with Chapter 163, Part II, Florida Statutes, and Rule 9J-5, Florida Administrative Code.

No affected person, as defined by Section 163.3184(1)(a), Florida Statutes, filed a petition challenging the Notice, and the time for doing so has expired.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, it is ORDERED that the above-captioned proceeding is DISMISSED, and the Agency Clerk is directed to close the file.

A COPY OF THE NOTICE OF APPEAL MUST BE FILED WITH THE APPROPRIATE DISTRICT COURT OF APPEAL AND MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY THE FILING FEE SPECIFIED IN SECTION 35.22(3), FLORIDA STATUTES.
