An Administrative Law Judge of the Division of Administrative Hearings has entered an Order Closing File in this proceeding. A copy of the Order is attached to this Final Order as Exhibit A.

BACKGROUND

This is a proceeding to determine whether the Hernando

County Comprehensive Plan Amendment 07-2, adopted by Ordinance

No. 2007-24 on December 12, 2007, as remediated by Comprehensive

Plan Amendment 09-R1, adopted by Ordinance No. 2009-03, on May

12, 2009, is "in compliance" with the Local Government

Comprehensive Planning and Land Development Regulation Act, Ch.

163, Part II, Florida Statutes (the "Act").

All parties to this proceeding entered into a Stipulated Settlement Agreement which required the County to adopt certain remedial amendments. The County adopted the remedial amendments

and the Department subsequently published its Cumulative Notice of Intent to find the Plan Amendment and the Remedial Amendment to be "in compliance" with Chapter 163, Part II, Florida Statutes, and Rule 9J-5, Florida Administrative Code.

A petition for hearing by Brooksville Quarry, LLC, was filed on July 15, 2009, pursuant to Section 163.3184(9), Florida Statutes, and assigned Case No. 09-3746GM. The Brooksville Quarry, LLC, petition challenged the Department's in compliance finding for the Hernando County remedial amendment adopted by Ordinance 2009-03. On August 3, 2009, a Notice of Hearing for Case No. 09-3746 was entered for September 1 and 2, 2009.

On August 10, 2009, Brooksville Quarry, LLC, filed a Notice of Voluntary Dismissal without Prejudice. An Order entered August 11, 2009, canceled the hearing set for September 1 and 2, 2009, and relinquished jurisdiction for Case No. 09-3746GM back to the Department for entry of a Final Order. No disputed issues remain to be resolved in Case No. 08-1041GM, and the time for filing a petition has expired.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, it is ORDERED that the above-captioned proceeding is DISMISSED, and the Agency Clerk is directed to close the file.

A COPY OF THE NOTICE OF APPEAL MUST BE FILED WITH THE APPROPRIATE DISTRICT COURT OF APPEAL AND MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY THE FILING FEE SPECIFIED IN SECTION 35.22(3), FLORIDA STATUTES.
