After review of the record, including the transcript of proceedings and admitted exhibits, and being otherwise fully apprised in all material premises,



IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Millenium Homes, Inc. shall cease all business operations unless and until it provides evidence satisfactory to the Division of Workers' Compensation of having now complied with the workers' compensation law by securing the necessary workers' compensation insurance coverage for covered

employees and, pursuant to Section 440.107(7)(a), Florida Statutes, paying the civil penalty imposed herein.
