FINAL ORDER

THIS CAUSE came on for consideration of and final agency action on the Recommended Order rendered by Administrative Law Judge Larry J. Sartin on August 21, 2009, subsequent to a hearing held on May 13, 2009, in Lauderdale Lakes and Tallahassee, Florida via video teleconference. No exceptions were filed.

After review of the record, including the transcript of proceedings and admitted exhibits, and being otherwise fully apprised in all material premises,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the ALJ's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth in the Recommended Order are adopted as the Department's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the licenses and eligibility for licensure of Respondent Joan Lorraine Dragone are suspended for a period of 21 months from the date hereof. Suspension of Dragone's licenses and eligibility for licensure applies to all licenses and eligibility held by Dragone under the Florida Insurance Code.

Pursuant to Section 624.641, Florida Statutes, during the period of suspension and until reinstatement, which must be applied for in writing, Dragone shall not engage in or attempt or profess to engage in any transaction or business for which a license is

required under the Florida Insurance Code, or directly or indirectly own, control, or be employed in any manner by an insurance agent, agency, or adjuster or adjusting firm.
