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FINAL ORDER

The Division of Florida Land Sales, Condominiums, and Mobile Homes ("Division"), enters this Final Order against Waterfront Park Corporation ("Respondent").

PRELIMINARY STATEMENT

The Division issued a Notice to Show Cause to Waterfront Park Corporation on February 6, 2009, in Division Case Number 2008036671, advising Respondent that the Division had evidence that Respondent violated section 719.104(3), Florida Statutes. Respondent was advised of the right to

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request either a formal or informal proceeding within twenty-one (21) days of the Notice, in accordance with Chapter 120, Florida Statutes.

On February 10, 2009, the Notice to Show Cause was sent by U.S. certified mail to Robert B. Kendrick, President of Respondent. On February 27, 2009, Respondent mailed to the Division a Response to the Notice to Show Cause, which challenged the allegation set forth in the Notice to Show Cause and requested a formal hearing. On March 10, 2009, the case was forwarded to the Division of Administrative Hearings ("DOAH"). The procedural history of the proceedings before DOAH are set out by the Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") in the Recommended Order, which is incorporated in this Final Order.

On October 30, 2009, the ALJ entered a Recommended Order, recommending that the Division enter a Final Order finding that Respondent did not violate section 719.104(3), Florida Statutes, and that the Division rescind the Notice to Show Cause. The Recommended Order is attached hereto and fully incorporated herein.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Division hereby adopts and incorporates by reference the Findings of Fact numbered 1 through 37 as set forth in the Recommended Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

2. The Division hereby adopts and incorporates by reference the Conclusions of Law numbered 38 though 53 as set forth in the Recommended Order.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the ALJ's Recommended Order is adopted by the Division, and the Notice to Show Cause against Respondent for an alleged violation of section 719.104(3), Florida Statutes, is rescinded.
