FINAL ORDER

The Respondent is a licensed food service establishment pursuant to section 381.0072, Florida Statutes. The Respondent, having been charged with numerous statutory and rule violations, this matter was referred to the Division of Administrative Hearings for an adjudicatory proceeding pursuant to section 120.57(1), Florida Statutes.

The Administrative Law Judge (hereinafter the ALJ) assigned by the Division of Administrative Hearings has entered a recommended order of October 20, 2009, and this matter is now before the Department of Health for disposition. The ALJ recommends ultimate findings as follows: the Respondent, Whistle Stop Lounge, Incorporated, is guilty of repeated violations as follows: one, failing to take effective measures for controlling vermin, two, causing or allowing potentially hazardous food to be prepared on the premises, and three, failing to comply with requirements for storing and disposing of garbage. The ALJ recommends disposition as follows: imposition of administrative fines totaling nine thousand six hundred and twenty-five dollars (\$9,625); and revocation of the Respondent's licensure to operate as a food service establishment. These findings and disposition are accepted and adjudicated by the Department.

The Recommended Order of October 20, 2009 is adopted in toto and incorporated by reference.
