THIS CAUSE came on for consideration of and final agency action on the Recommended Order rendered by Administrative Law Judge William F. Quattlebaum on September 9, 2009, subsequent to a hearing held on July 21, 2009, in Tallahassee, Florida. No exceptions were filed.

After review of the record, including the transcript of proceedings and admitted exhibits, and being otherwise fully apprised in all material premises,

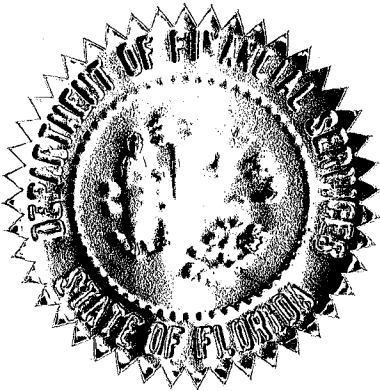
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the ALJ's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth in the Recommended Order are adopted as the Department's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Stop Work-Order and Amended Order of Penalty Assessment issued against David Bumgarner, (d/b/a "Builders and Assemblers") is affirmed and a penalty in the amount of \$1,764,643.98 is to be paid to the Department within 30 days of the date hereof.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that David Bumgarner shall cease all business operations unless and until it provides evidence satisfactory to the Division of Workers' Compensation of having now complied with the workers' compensation law by securing the necessary workers' compensation insurance coverage for covered

employees and, pursuant to Section 440.107(7)(a), Florida Statutes, paying the civil penalty imposed herein.
