FINAL ORDER

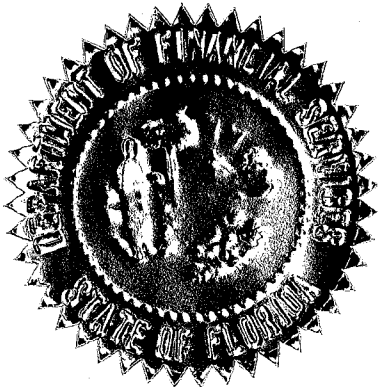
THIS CAUSE came on for consideration of and final agency action on the Recommended Order rendered by Administrative Law Judge Carolyn S. Holifield on September 16, 2010, subsequent to a hearing held on November 9, 2009, in Tallahassee, Florida via video teleconference. No exceptions were filed.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the ALJ's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth in the Recommended Order are adopted as the Department's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Second Amended Order of Penalty Assessment (Penalty Only) entered by the Division of Workers' Compensation against A&M Painting Services, Inc. is imposed, and that A & M Painting Services, Inc. shall pay to the Department the assessment penalty of \$91,455.63, within thirty (30) days from the date hereof or enter into a Payment Agreement Schedule.
