## **FINAL ORDER**

Having reviewed the Administrative Complaint in the above-style matter, the Order Closing file entered by Claude B. Arrington for the Division of Administrative Hearings entered on April 13, 2010, and the Order on Motion to Dismiss Petition for Formal Hearing and for Entry of Final Order entered by the Agency Clerk from the Agency for Health Care Administration dated May 20, 2013, and all other matters of record, the Agency for Health Care Administration (hereinafter "the Agency"), finds and concludes as follows:

- The Agency sought a \$2,000.00 fine against the Respondent based upon two unclassified 1. deficiencies. The Agency charged that Respondent failed to: (a) comply with the home health agency requirements that at least one qualifying service is provided to patients as a direct service in violation of Sections 400.474(2)(e), 400.462(9), Florida Statutes, and/or Rules 59A-8.008(4), and 59A-8.002(31), Florida Administrative Code; (b) accurately chart patients' progress by charting ahead and documenting services not provided at the time indicated in violation of Section 400.474(2), Florida Statutes. - On October 20, 2009, the above-styled matter was referred for a formal hearing to the Division of Administrative Hearings. On April 12, 2010, the Respondent filed an Agreed Motion to Remand the case to the Agency. On April 13, 2010, the Division of Administrative Hearings enter an Order Closing the File. On May 8, 2013, the Agency filed a Motion to Dismiss Petition for Formal Hearing and Entry of Final Order. On May 20, 2013, the Agency Clerk entered an Order on Motion to Dismiss Petition for Formal Hearing and for Entry of a Final Order. (Ex. 2)

Based upon the foregoing, it is ORDERED:

The Respondent shall pay the Agency \$2,000.00. If full payment has been made, the cancelled check acts as receipt of payment and no further payment is required. If full payment has not been made, payment is due within 30 days of the Final Order. Overdue amounts are subject to statutory interest and may be referred to collections. REVIEW OF PROCEEDINGS SHALL BE CONDUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FLORIDA APPELLATE RULES. THE NOTICE OF APPEAL MUST BE FILED WITHIN 30 DAYS OF RENDITION OF THE ORDER TO BE REVIEWED.
