## SCHOOL BOARD FINAL ORDER

Pursuant to notice, a formal hearing was held on March 31, 2010, before the Division of Administrative Hearings by Administrative Law Judge J.D. Parrish. The subject matter of the hearing was whether Petitioner had a legal basis to terminate Respondent.

#### I. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

Judge Parrish issued a Recommended Order on May 28, 2010. Judge Parrish determined that Respondent failed her employment and contractual duty to achieve highly qualified status; and Respondent demonstrated a lack of capacity to perform the educational duties required by the employer. Judge Parrish recommended that Respondent enter a final order terminating Respondent's employment but allowing Respondent leave in the future to reapply with the District for any position that may fall open for which she is qualified and certified to teach.

No exceptions were timely filed by either party.

### II. FINDINGS

Pursuant to §120.57(1)(1), Florida Statutes, the School Board adopts the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained in the Recommended Order attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

### III. FINAL RULING

Based on the foregoing, the School Board hereby approves the recommendation of the Superintendent that Cheryl Rayam's employment with the School Board of Lake County is terminated.

The parties have thirty (30) days from the rendition of this Final Order to file a Notice of Appeal in accordance with §120.68, Florida Statutes.
