FINAL ORDER

THIS CAUSE came before the Board (Board) pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, on July 15, 2010, in Celebration, Florida, for the purpose of considering the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Order (attached hereto as Exhibit 1) in the above-styled case. Petitioner was represented by LeChea Parson, Assistant General Counsel. Respondent was neither present nor represented counsel.

Petitioner filed an Administrative Complaint (Exhibit 2) against the Respondent alleging that Respondent violated provisions of the Electrical Contractors' Practice Act. Respondent disputed the facts alleged in the Administrative Complaint and requested an evidentiary hearing before the Division of Administrative Hearings ("DOAH"). This matter was referred to DOAH and on May 4, 2010, an evidentiary hearing was held before the Honorable Lisa Scherer Nelson, Administrative Law Judge. On June 21, 2010, Judge Nelson issued her Recommended Order.

Neither party filed exceptions to the Recommended Order.

After a complete review of the record in this matter, the Board makes the following findings and conclusions:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The findings of fact set forth in the Recommended Order are approved and adopted and incorporated by reference herein.
2. There is competent substantial evidence to support the findings of fact.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction of this matter pursuant to Section 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, and Chapter 489, Florida Statutes.
2. The conclusions of law set forth in the Recommended Order are approved and adopted and incorporated by reference herein.

RECOMMENDATION

Upon a complete review of the record in this case, the Board determines that the dismissal of the Administrative Complaint as recommended by the Administrative Law Judge is appropriate and ACCEPTED the recommendation.

WHEREFORE,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

The Administrative Complaint filed in this cause is hereby **DISMISSED**.

This Final Order shall take effect upon being filed with the Clerk of the Department of Business and Professional Regulation.
